WOOF RANCH DOG PARK OPEN FOR ROMPING AND JUMPING

Resident participation is critical to the health of any neighborhood, and the Wolf Ranch community is fortunate to have the ideas and efforts of several residents make the community a better place to live.

Thanks to Drew Kosmowski, a resident who submitted the idea of a "WOOF Ranch" Dog Park back in 2007. In 2011, the construction was made possible by three young residents from Boy Scout Troop 62 who decided to plan and build WOOF Ranch Dog Park as their Eagle Scout project. Thanks to the creative design and hard labor of Zachary, Josh and Jake Hullings WOOF Ranch Dog Park is now open to everyone.

The dog park entrance is located on the west side of Tutt Boulevard between Wolf Village Drive and Revelstoke Drive, across from Ranch Creek Elementary School. On-street parking is plentiful, and the walking path winds up to the entrance of the WOOF Ranch Dog Park. Overflow parking is available at the elementary school.

The dog park is natural landscaping and amenities include:

- Small dog area
- Large dog area
- Agility section with 9 pieces of equipment
- 6 benches for sitting
- Dog trash station
- Leash dock for hanging leashes
- Bulletin board for information
- Bring your own water

There is a sign with Laws of the Pack, which includes the continual message: Please pick up after your pets.

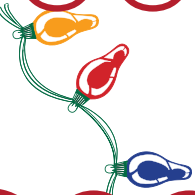
